ACE Herd update

Production for the 13/14 season was 153,587 kg MS, a record for the Association in this sharemilking postition. The farm is set up well for next season with enough crop and supplement for the winter. The runoff area is being utilised to gain the best from the milking block and we look forward to increased production next season. There has been culling done on mastitis and SCC and the whole herd has been dry-cowed and teat-sealed. We hope this will reduce our somatic cell count next season. We have also purchased 10 yearlings so we have a good number of replacements for the following season. Special thanks to our sharemilkers, James Burnby & family, for their great effort and continued support.

Registration is free for all heifers sired by Semayr Sire Proving bulls and free TOP classification is available for all 2 year old heifers as long as 20% of your 2 yr olds are sired by Semayr Progeny Test bulls.
